DTX900 Extension is software which lets you operate the Cubase functions from the DTX900 as a remote controller. For example, you can operate the Cubase transport, turn its metronome on or off, and control various other functions from the instrument's front panel.

Minimum System Requirements

Windows/Macintosh

The system requirements of DTX900 Extension are the same as Cubase / Cubase Studio / Cubase Essential / Cubase AI version 5.1.1 or later.

Software Installation

To use the DTX900 Extension, you will need to install additional applications, as described below.

- 1 Install one of the Cubase series software (Cubase / Cubase Studio / Cubase Essential / Cubase AI).**
- 2 Install an appropriate USB-MIDI Driver.**

Installing the DTX900 Extension

Follow the instructions below to install the DTX900 Extension programs.

Windows

- 1 After the downloaded compressed file is properly extracted, double-click the “setup.exe” file.**
The DTX900 Extension setup dialog appears.

NOTE When using Windows Vista / Windows 7, if the “User Account Control” window appears, click [Continue] / [Yes].

- 2 Follow the on-screen instructions to install the software.**

Macintosh

- 1 After the downloaded compressed file is properly extracted, double-click the “Yamaha DTX900 Extension.pkg” file.**

The DTX900 Extension setup dialog appears.

- 2 Follow the on-screen instructions to install the software.**

DTX900 Extension Uninstall

When using Windows XP

- 1** From the Start menu, select ([Settings] →) [Control Panel] → [Add or Remove Programs] to display the “Add or Remove Programs” panel.
- 2** Click “Change or Remove Programs” located in the upper left, then select “Yamaha DTX900 Extension” from the list in the right pane.
- 3** Click [Change/Remove].
A dialog box appears. Follow the instructions to remove the software.

When using Windows Vista / Windows 7

- 1** From the Start menu, select ([Settings] →) [Control Panel] → [Programs and Features] to display the “Uninstall or change a program” window.
- 2** Select “Yamaha DTX900 Extension” from the list.
- 3** Click [Uninstall/Change].
If the “User Account Control” window appears, click [Continue] / [Yes].
A dialog box appears. Follow the instructions to remove the software.

When using a Macintosh computer

- 1** Select [Library] → [Application Support] → [Steinberg] → [Components], then delete the below files.

[◀◀]	Rewinds the transport (REW).
[▶▶]	Fast forwards the transport (FF).
[REC]	Starts recording.
[▶/■]	Starts and stops playback.
[CLICK ON/OFF]	Turns the click track on and off.
[🔊]	Turns Solo Defeat of the currently selected track on and off.
[F1]	Quantize*
[F2]	Undo*
[F3]	Zoom In*
[F4]	Zoom Out*
[F5]	Zoom in the selected track*
[F6]	Zoom out the selected track*
[SF1]	Not assigned *
[SF2]	Not assigned *
[SF3]	Not assigned *
[SF4]	Not assigned *
[SF5]	Not assigned *
[SF6]	Not assigned *
[-1/DEC], [+1/INC]	Moves the project cursor by 1 bar.
[INC/YES]	Decreases the program number of the currently selected VST instrument by 1.
[DEC/NO]	Increases the program number of the currently selected VST instrument by 1.
[⤴]	Selects the previous track.
[⤵]	Selects the next track.
[<]	Selects the previous track.
[>]	Selects the next track.
[CHAIN]+[SAMPLING]	Turns the Cubase Remote function on and off.

* You can assign any Cubase function to the button. Cubase functions assigned to these buttons can be changed as desired from the Device Setup menu in Cubase.
